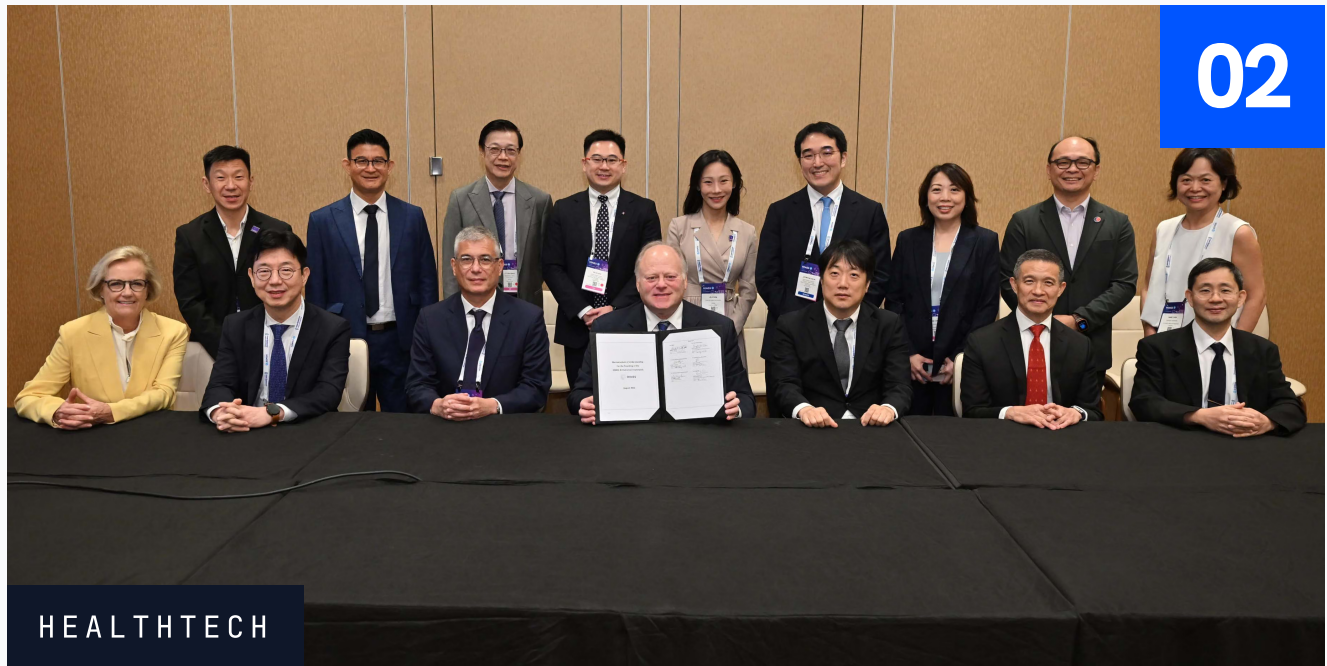
Abbott's Libre Duo Gets FDA Nod as First Dual Glucose-Ketone Monitor

The FDA has granted De Novo marketing authorization to Abbott for its Libre Duo 10 Day system — the world's first integrated continuous glucose and ketone monitoring (iCGK) device. The wearable monitors glucose while continuously tracking rising ketones in the background, establishing a new regulatory benchmark alongside standard iCGM status. A significant leap forward in metabolic health monitoring.

HIMSS Launches World's First AI Outcomes Measurement Standard

At the HIMSS26 APAC Health Conference in Singapore, HIMSS signed two major MOUs and established the HIMSS AI Outcomes Framework — described as the world's first evidence-based, longitudinal standard for measuring the clinical, operational, and financial impact and ROI of AI in healthcare. A critical step toward accountability and trust in clinical AI deployment.

ECRI Expands Network to Track Clinical AI Errors and Near Misses

Global patient safety nonprofit ECRI has expanded its Problem Reporting Network to explicitly capture, investigate, and triage errors, malfunctions, and near misses involving AI tools and AI-enabled medical devices used in patient care. The move addresses a critical clinical oversight gap as AI is deployed across diagnostic imaging, clinical decision support, and more. Proactive safety infrastructure for the AI era.

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UPMC Scales AI Care Management Across 18 Hospitals

UPMC is expanding its AI-native transitional care management program to 18 hospitals, scaling from a single-campus pilot at UPMC Jameson to 10 live sites today with more launching in September. The program runs on Andor Health's ThinkAndor® agentic AI infrastructure, paired with Psynergy Health. This is one of the most ambitious real-world deployments of agentic AI in clinical care coordination to date.
